The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Commits Act to Cause Fear of Immediate Bodily Harm or Death

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/07/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016576

Charge Description: On or about August 7, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Tracy Lynn Frederick, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death.

COUNT II

Charge: Disorderly Conduct - Brawling or Fighting

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/07/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016576

Charge Description: On or about August 7, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Tracy Lynn Frederick, did, in a public or private place, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in brawling or fighting.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 7, 2026, Deputies from the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to a report of a domestic incident within Eagle Lake in Blue Earth County. The caller, Tracy Lynn Frederick (DOB: 08/27/1965), told dispatch that her and her husband, Victim 1, were in an argument and a physical altercation.

Frederick spoke with Deputy Brashear about the incident. Frederick told Deputy Brashear that, she was in an argument with her husband, Victim 1, that turned into a physical altercation. During that altercation, Frederick told Deputy Brashear that she slapped Victim 1 in the head and told him that she wishes she had a gun because she would shoot him. Victim 1 was concerned enough to then go grab his own firearm. Frederick confirmed to Deputies that both she and Victim 1 own firearms that are located within the residence.

Deputy Lewis spoke with Victim 1. Victim 1 informed Deputy Lewis that Frederick pushed Victim 1 and then he pushed Frederick back in retaliation and Frederick fell to the floor. Victim 1 stated that he then left the room to go lay on the couch. Victim 1 stated that Frederick then walked by and hit Victim 1 in the head and threatened Victim 1 with a firearm. Victim 1 indicated that he never saw Frederick have a firearm during this incident.

Deputies noted the odor of alcoholic beverages emanating from both individuals' person.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
