COMPLAINT

Summons

Amended

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Violate No Contact Order - Within 10 years of the first of two or more convictions

Minnesota Statute: 629.75.2(d)(1), with reference to: 629.75.2(d)

Maximum Sentence: 30 days to 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/14/2025 to 11/16/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25002120

Charge Description: On or between November 14, 2025 and November 16, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jordan James Kenady Rollings did violate a Domestic Abuse No-Contact Order and the respondent or person to be restrained knew of the existence of the order and the violation within ten years of the first of two or more previous qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 15, 2025, Sgt Baker of the Mapleton Police Department learned that Jordan James Kenady Rollings (DOB 03/14/1993) had violated a Domestic Assault No Contact Order (DANCO). A witness reported seeing Rollings get into a vehicle with Protected Party. The vehicle was parked behind Protected Party's residence. The witness recognized both Rollings and the Protected Party. The witness was aware of the DANCO requiring Rollings to stay away from Protected Party. Sgt. Baker and other law enforcement officers went to the residence and noted that Protected Person's residence had newly installed security cameras and that black plastic covering had been recently placed over the window in the front door. The officers were not able to contact the Protected Person or Rollings.

On September 22, 2025, Rollings appeared in front of Judge Anderson in Blue Earth County District Court file 07-CR-25-3763. Rollings was charged with two counts of Felony Domestic Assault involving Victim 1/ Protected Person. At that hearing, Judge Anderson ordered the defendant to have no contact, direct or indirect with the victim Protected Person. The Release Order includes that Rollings "stay a reasonable distance from Victim's residence with no direct or indirect contact, and that Rollings remain law abiding.

The Release Order also includes the following language: "The terms of this order will remain in effect until another court order changes or vacates this order, until you are found not guilty of the criminal charges in this case, until the charges against you are dismissed, or until the sentencing in this case."

Immediately after the criminal hearing, the Court commenced a second hearing dealing with the State's request for a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO). The Court ordered the DANCO be issued including the following language: "You are ordered to have no contact directly, indirectly or through others, in person, by telephone, in writing, electronically or by any other means with the protected person named above." The DANCO includes, printed within a black bordered box in all capital letters, the following advisory: THIS ORDER WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL DISPOSITION OF THE CASE OR UNTIL FURTHER ORDER OR MODIFICATION. The DANCO was personally served on the Defendant.

There have been three attempts to vacate the DANCO in 07-CR-25-3763 and the requests were each denied: October 3, 2025 (Judge Jass); October 13, 2025 (Judge Lieser); and October 30, 2025 (Judge Anderson).

The Defendant has been convicted of two Qualified Domestic Violence-related Offenses within the last ten years: 07-CR-17-3643 Felony Stalking (12/14/18), and 07-CR-17-92 Assault 3rd Degree (12/14/18).

The Defendant failed to appear for a scheduled omnibus hearing in 07-CR-25-3763 on November 24, 2025. A "Body Only" Bench Warrant was issued on November 25, 2025, by Judge Better. The Defendant's whereabouts are currently unknown. A Complaint Warrant is accordingly requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
