The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault - 4th Deg - Physician, nurse or other emergency room personnel

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.2(a)(2), with reference to: 609.2231.2(a)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/29/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020247

Charge Description: On or about June 29, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Brandon Gerald Ross, did, physically assault a physician, nurse, or other person providing health care services in a hospital emergency department.

COUNT II

Charge: Assault-5th Deg-Inflict or Attempt Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/29/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020247

Charge Description: On or about June 29, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Brandon Gerald Ross, did intentionally inflict or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Late in the evening on June 29, 2026, Officer Slattery from the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to Business 1 in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, following a report of assaults there.

Brandon Gerald Ross (DOB: 01/30/1991) was transported by Ross's wife to Business 1, a hospital, for care that evening because Ross was heavily intoxicated. Ross was placed on a 72-hour hold by emergency room doctors.

Victim 1, a security guard at Business 1, reported Ross became belligerent toward Ross's wife and hospital staff to the point staff determined Ross needed to be restrained. While Victim 1 tried to control Ross's legs to prevent Ross from kicking staff, Ross grabbed Victim 1's right arm in the bicep area, breaking skin on Victim 1's arm.

Ross told Officer Slattery Ross recalled grabbing onto a security guard's arm while Ross was being restrained at Business 1 but denied that Ross did it to cause Victim 1 harm.

Victim 2 is a nurse in the Emergency Room at Business 1. Victim 2 told Officer Slattery Victim 2 heard Ross screaming, "fuck you, Chinese! Fuck you all!" while Ross was at Business 1. Victim 2 described efforts to restrain, medicate, and calm Ross due to Ross's conduct. Victim 2 reported that while staff were adjusting restraints on Ross, Ross grabbed Victim 2's left hand, near Victim 2's finger, and pulled it back seemingly as hard as Ross could, causing Victim 2 to cry out in pain.

Security assisted Victim 2 and were able to get Victim 2's hand free from Ross's grip.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
