COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Physically Assaults

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(b), with reference to: 609.2231.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/05/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25016028

Charge Description: On or about June 5, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Zachary Tyler Hansen did physically assault a peace officer when that officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT II

Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/05/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25016028

Charge Description: On or about June 5, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Zachary Tyler Hansen did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

COUNT III

Charge: Assault-5th Deg-Inflict or Attempt Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/05/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25016028

Charge Description: On or about June 5, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Zachary Tyler Hansen, did intentionally inflict or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 5, 2025, at approximately 6:21 PM, dispatch received a report of an assault occurring at a group home in the City of Mankato. Witness 1, a staff member at the home, informed dispatch that Zachary Tyler Hansen had grabbed a knife, was threatening staff and had punched a staff member.

Ofc. Brianna Wagner, with the Mankato Department of Public Safety, was the first officer to arrive on scene. When she arrived on the scene, Ofc. Wagner observed Witness 1 running down the sidewalk away from the residence. Hansen was chasing after Witness 1.

Ofc. Wagner approached Hansen, who had begun walking back toward the residence. Ofc. Wagner, knowing that there were knives at the residence, told Hansen to stop walking away. Hansen refused and Ofc. Wagner moved toward Hansen to perform a controlled takedown. As Officer Wagner was approaching Hansen, Hansen turned, balled up his fist and swung at Officer Wagner's face.

Ofc. Wagner was able to deflect much of the force from the swing. Hansen continued to attempt to injure Ofc. Wagner by swinging closed fists toward her head and torso. Hansen was unable to make significant contact with Ofc. Wagner.

Ofc. Wagner was yelling at Hansen to stop but Hansen continued to strike Ofc. Wagner. Victim 1, another staff member from the home, assisted Ofc. Wagner in getting control of Hansen.

Ofc. Wagner was attempting to place handcuffs on Hansen and Hansen continued to obstruct, aggressively bringing his elbows back into Ofc. Wagner so that she could not handcuff him.

Eventually, Ofc. Wagner was able to handcuff Hansen. Sgt. Kelly Wood arrived on the scene and assisted Ofc. Wagner with standing up Hansen.

Officer Maxwell strong also arrived on the scene and assisted. Ofc. Strong spoke with Victim 1, who stated that Hansen had punched him in the face causing injury.

Sgt. Wood spoke with spoke with Witness 1. Witness 1 stated that she witnessed Hansen punch Victim 1.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
