The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Aid and Abet Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.05.1, 609.11.4

Maximum Sentence: 7 years or \$14,000 fine or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/01/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016117

Charge Description: On or about August 1, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Adam Richard Domeier, did intentionally aid, advise, hire, counsel, or conspire with, or otherwise procure another to commit the crime, and/or did personally commit said crime; to wit: did assault another with a dangerous weapon.

COUNT II

Charge: Assault-5th Deg-Inflict or Attempt Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/01/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016117

Charge Description: On or about August 1, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Adam Richard Domeier, did intentionally inflict or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 1, 2026, deputies of the Blue Earth County Sheriff's office were dispatched to a residence in Blue Earth County Minnesota on report of an assault. Officers learned that Victim 1 and Victim 2 were the victims of the assault.

Deputy Purvis spoke with Victim 1. Victim 1 stated he heard a knock on the door. Victim 1 opened the door and a male, later identified as Joseph William Eng, started accusing Victim 1 of robbing him. Eng then reached inside and struck Victim 1 causing him to fall outside the residence. Victim 1 stated he was then hit on the forearm and hit with the bat. Victim 1 estimated that he was struck about five times with the bat/club. Victim 1 stated that another male, later identified as Adam Richard Domeier, grabbed him when he was on the ground and Victim 1 described feeling something on his hand and believing he was stabbed.

Victim 1 said that Domeier then "smoked" Victim 2, causing her to fall to the ground. Victim 1 said Domeier also had a bat. Deputies observed injuries to Victim 1, including a large laceration on his hand.

Victim 2 said she was hit in the head while Victim 1 was assaulted by Eng and Domeier. Deputies observed a lump on her head. Victim 2 stated she was 100% sure it was Domeier and Eng.

Detective Steinbach conducted two photo lineups with Victim 1. Victim 1 identified Domeier in the first line up. Victim 1 said he was "very sure" that was one of the males who was present and involved in the assault.

Victim 1 identified Eng in the second line up. Victim 1 said that is the man that stabbed him, hit his wife, and him.

Deputies searched for Eng and Domeier. Eng and Domeier's whereabouts are unknown, and they are a danger to public safety. A warrant is requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
