COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 1st Degree - Sale - 17 Grams or More-Cocaine or Meth w/in 90-Day Period

Minnesota Statute: 152.021.1(1), with reference to: 152.021.3(b)

Maximum Sentence: Commitment for not less than four years nor more than 40 years, a fine of \$1,000,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008104

Charge Description: On or about March 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Casey Ann Voneschen did within a 90 day period, unlawfully sell one or more mixtures of a total weight of 17 grams or more containing cocaine or methamphetamine and said Defendant was previously convicted of a controlled substance crime.

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 1st Degree - Possess 50 grams or more - cocaine or methamphetamine

Minnesota Statute: 152.021.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.021.3(b)

Maximum Sentence: Commitment for not less than four years nor more than 40 years, a fine of \$1,000,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008104

Charge Description: On or about March 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Casey Ann Voneschen did possess one or more mixtures of a total weight of 50 grams or more containing methamphetamine, and said Defendant was previously convicted of a controlled substance crime.

COUNT III

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008104

Charge Description: On or about March 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Casey Ann Voneschen, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe, after having been previously convicted of a violation of Chapter 152.

COUNT IV

Charge: Dangerous Weapons-Possesses any other dangerous article or substance

Minnesota Statute: 609.66.1(a)(5), with reference to: 609.66.1(b)(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days, \$1,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008104

Charge Description: On or about March 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Casey Ann Voneschen did possesses any other dangerous article or substance for the purpose of being used unlawfully as a weapon against another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 13, 2026, a Judge in the Fifth Judicial District approved an application for a search warrant submitted by Agent Ehlers from the Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force. The warrant authorized law enforcement to search Casey Ann Voneschen (DOB: 01/10/1977) and a 2008 Ford Edge vehicle of which Voneschen is the registered owner.

On March 18, 2026, Agent Ehlers observed Voneschen's vehicle was parked at Business 1 in the City of Mankato, where Voneschen works. Around 1:25 p.m. when Voneschen walked to her vehicle, agents made contact with her and explained they had a warrant to search Voneschen and her vehicle.

After Ehlers read Voneschen the Miranda warning and Voneschen said she understood her rights, Voneschen said she had three ounces in a white bag in her car which she got from the cities, there were hypodermic needles, baggies and a scale in the white bag, she had mushrooms in a black case in the back seat, there was methamphetamine in two separate plastic bags and maybe a little more than three ounces, she sells controlled substances to get by, she usually sells in ounces, and she sells ounces for \$250-\$300.

Inside the vehicle, Agent Voegel located the following items: multiple zip bags of various sizes with crystal-like residue, plastic bags with red fruit designs containing a crystal-like substance that field-tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed 40.6 grams, a plastic bag containing a crystal-like substance that field-tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed 54.3 grams, a digital scale with crystal-like substance on it, an electronic incapacitation device, pepper spray, and documents addressed to Voneschen. Agents also found 7.4 grams of psilocybin mushrooms that field-tested positive for mushrooms.

Voneschen was convicted of a 1st Degree Drug Sale offense on April 19, 2022, in Court File No. 07-CR-22-494.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
