The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault-5th Deg-2/More Prev Convict in 3 years**

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/20/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008297

Charge Description: On or about March 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kayla Sue Tyser, did intentionally inflict or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another and has two or more previous qualified domestic violence related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency within the previous 3 years.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

After midnight on March 20, 2026, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to a call at Business 1 in Blue Earth County. Kayla Sue Tyser (DOB: 01/22/1993) is a resident there. Police had responded to the same location earlier in the night, following reports Tyser was trying to hurt staff. Tyser reported to Officer Rutz that Tyser just felt like hurting people and did not know why.

Victim 1, a staff member at Business 1, told Officer Rutz that Tyser had been trying to hit Victim 1 and other staff members at Business 1. Victim 2 said Tyser tried to attack Victim 2, but Victim 2 and other staff members were able to prevent Tyser from attacking Victim 2.

Officer Wendell spoke with Victim 3 who had scratch marks on Victim 3's arms that Tyser caused. Victim 3 told police Tyser attacked another staff member earlier in the night, causing the staff member to seek hospital care. Victim 3 reported that Tyser spoke to Tyser's probation agent earlier in the day and advised the agent that Tyser was going to hurt staff at Business 1 in order to go to jail because Tyser wanted to go to jail. Victim 3 stated Tyser told staff Tyser wanted to hurt staff while chasing staff around Business 1.

Tyser has been convicted of the following qualified domestic violence-related offenses in the last ten years: (1) Threats of Violence – Court File No. 07-CR-25-1667 – convicted January 26, 2026; (2) Assault-4th Degree – Court File No. 07-CR-25-4260 – convicted January 26, 2026; (3) Assault-5th Degree – Court File No. 07-CR-25-4056 – convicted December 10, 2025; and (4) Assault-5th Degree – Court File No. 07-CR-25-2841 – convicted December 10, 2025.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
