COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Burglary - 4th Degree - Enters building w/out consent; Commit misdemeanor other than to steal

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.4(a)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days jail and/or \$3,000 fine

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/06/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26028681

Charge Description: On or about September 6, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Treyveon Tom Heuangsayaseng Jr., did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a misdemeanor other than to steal, or entered a building without consent and committed a misdemeanor other than to steal while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice.

COUNT II

Charge: Fleeing a Peace Officer By a Means Other Than a Motor Vehicle

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.6

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/06/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26028681

Charge Description: On or about September 6, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Treyveon Tom Heuangsayaseng Jr, did, for the purpose of avoiding arrest, detention, or investigation, attempted to evade or elude a peace officer who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, by means of running, hiding or any other means other than fleeing in a motor vehicle.

COUNT III

Charge: Trespass-Return to Property Within One Year

Minnesota Statute: 609.605.1(b)(8)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/06/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26028681

Charge Description: On or about September 6, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Treyveon Tom Heuangsayaseng Jr did return to the property of another within one year after being told to leave the property and not to return, and the actor is without claim of right to the property or consent of one with authority to consent.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 6, 2026, officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were on patrol near an apartment housing complex near the college campus within the City of Mankato. Officer Wagner had parked her squad car near the rear of one of the apartment buildings as law enforcement had received a call regarding a large fight involving approximately 30 people at the apartment complex.

Officer Wagner began walking down the roadway as officers were attempting to respond to the situation. Officer Wagner radioed that she was in pursuit of a male, later identified as Treyveon Tom Heuangsayaseng Jr. (DOB: 04/08/2005). Officer Hermanson responded to the area and heard footsteps on rocks nearby. Officer Hermanson rounded the corner of the clubhouse at the housing complex and observed Heuangsayaseng forcing open a door at the rear of the building. Officer Hermanson loudly identified himself as police to Heuangsayaseng and told Heuangsayaseng to stop. Heuangsayaseng continued to force the door open and entered the building.

Officer Hermanson followed Heuangsayaseng in through the open door of the clubhouse. Officer Hermanson observed Heuangsayaseng standing at the top of a staircase near the door and placed Heuangsayaseng under arrest.

Officer Wagner spoke with a security officer for the housing complex, Witness 1. Witness 1 stated that Heuangsayaseng is trespassed from the housing complex and the building that he had broken into without consent. He stated that Heuangsayaseng was violating the trespass order when he entered the building. Witness 1 also stated that the door that Heuangsayaseng opened takes significant effort to open as it is broken.

Officer Wagner and Officer Hermanson also spoke with Heuangsayaseng who stated that he knew he was trespassed from the property. Heuangsayaseng also told Officer Wagner that he thought he could get away from her if he ran. Heuangsayaseng told Officers Wagner and Hermanson that he ran because he wanted to avoid getting in trouble.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
