COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Liquor-Purchase/Sell/Barter/Furnish/Give to u/21yr

Minnesota Statute: 340A.503.2(1), with reference to: 340A.702(8)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days jail or a \$3,000 fine or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/17/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26022315

Charge Description: On or about July 17, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Emily Suzanne Brielmaier did sell, barter, furnish or give alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 17, 2026, Officer Wilkins and Officer Mohr with the Mankato Department of Public Safety were conducting Alcohol Compliance Checks with businesses who sell alcoholic beverages within the City of Mankato, including Business 1.

Officer Wilkins and Officer Mohr had a controlled buyer, Witness 1, go into Business 1 to attempt to purchase an alcoholic beverage. Witness 1 was under the age of 21 and utilized her own driver's license for the attempted purchases. Witness 1's driver's license lists "UNDER 21" below her photograph.

Witness 1 entered Business 1 and was sold an alcoholic beverage by Emily Suzanne Brielmaier (DOB: 12/06/2006). After being served the beverage, Witness 1 sent a text to Officer Wilkins to tell her that Witness 1 had been served an alcoholic beverage. Officer Mohr and Officer Wilkins entered Business 1 and approached Witness 1, who was seated by herself at the bar. When they approached Witness 1, they saw a beer sitting on the counter in front of Witness 1 and observed Brielmaier to be the sole employee behind the bar. Witness 1 reported that Brielmaier had not asked to see Witness 1's identification and that Brielmaier had sold her the alcoholic beverage.

Officer Wilkins and Officer Mohr spoke with Brielmaier. Brielmaier confirmed that she sold the alcoholic beverage to Witness 1, who is under 21 years old, and did not ask to see Witness 1's identification prior to serving her with the alcoholic beverage.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
