The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Violate No Contact Order - Within 10 years of the first of two or more convictions

Minnesota Statute: 629.75.2(d)(1), with reference to: 629.75.2(d)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/17/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26007963

Charge Description: On or about March 17, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Aaron Lee Morgan did violate a Domestic Abuse No-Contact Order and the respondent or person to be restrained knew of the existence of the order and the violation within ten years of the first of two or more previous qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 17, 2026, Officer Austin Cook of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to contact Victim who reported that she has Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO) in place against Aaron Lee Morgan (9-17-1994) and he has violated that order. She had previously contacted the County Attorney's Office to report a DANCO Violation by Morgan. The County Attorney's Office advised her to call law enforcement to report on her situation.

Officer Cook made contact with Victim via phone and Victim indicated that there is a current DANCO in place between her and Morgan. She reported that while at work on March 17, 2026, in the City of Mankato, within Blue Earth County she was notified of a Facebook friend request from Aaron Morgan. She was then notified it was deleted and then re-sent. Victim also advised she has received notifications from Morgan following her TikTok account as well as liking a post. Victim provided screenshots of the requests. Officer Cook observed the screenshots the activity by a profile with the name "Aaron Morgan Wall" on both Facebook and TikTok. It was also observed that the profile pictures of those accounts looked like Morgan in comparison to his Driver's License photo.

Officer Cook then called Morgan who stated that he was on Facebook and TikTok in the early morning of March 17, 2026. He indicated that he received notifications that Victim was viewing his profile. He then clicked on the notification which brought him to her profile. While doing so he followed her accounts. Morgan also confirmed that the "Aaron Morgan Wall" are his accounts.

On March 18, 2026, Officer Cook requested Morgan come to the Public Safety Center. After some discussion regarding the incident Officer Cook Placed Morgan under arrest and transported him to the Blue Earth County Jail.

Morgan's Criminal History was reviewed, and it was discovered that he has two previous qualified domestic related offense convictions from September 2016-Felony Strangulation, and November 2017 Gross Misdemeanor Domestic Assault.

There is currently a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order in place where Aaron Lee Morgan is listed as the Defendant and Victim is listed as the Protected Person stemming from Criminal Court File 07-CR-25-3816.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
