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**COMPLAINT**

Warrant

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Burglary-1st Deg-Assault Person In Build/On Property**

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.1(c)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$35,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008742

Charge Description: On or about March 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jeremy James Hansen did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice and the burglar assaults a person within the building or on the building's appurtenant property.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Burglary-1st Deg-Poss Dangerous Weapon/Explosive**

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$35,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008742

Charge Description: On or about March 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jeremy James Hansen did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice and the burglar possessed, when entering or at any time while in the building, any of the following: a dangerous weapon, any article used or fashioned in a manner to lead the victim to reasonably believe it to be a dangerous weapon, or an explosive.

### COUNT III

**Charge: Burglary-1st Deg-Dwelling-Occupied-Non-Accomplice Present**

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.1(a), with reference to: 609.582.1a

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$35,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008742

Charge Description: On or about March 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jeremy James Hansen did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice and the building is a dwelling and another person, not an accomplice, is present in it when the burglar enters or at any time while the burglar is in the building.

### COUNT IV

**Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk**

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008742

Charge Description: On or about March 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jeremy James Hansen, did, threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

### COUNT V

**Charge: Assault-5th Degree-Fear of Bodily Harm or Death**

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008742

Charge Description: On or about March 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jeremy James Hansen, did commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death.

### COUNT VI

**Charge: Disorderly Conduct - Offensive/Abusive/Boisterous/Noisy/Obscene**

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/23/2026

Charge Description: On or about March 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jeremy James Hansen did, in a public or private place, including on a school bus, knowing, or having reasonable

grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 23, 2026, at approximately 10:11 PM, officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence in Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, on report of a burglary. Victim 1 called 911 and reported that Jeremy (James) Hansen just muscled his way in. Victim 1 also reported that Hansen had a gas can and a lighter and is now inside the house. A few minutes later, Victim 1 told dispatch that Hansen had left.

Sergeant Wood arrived and spoke with Victim 1 who stated he did not know why Hansen had come to his house. Victim 1 used to let Hansen stay at his house occasionally as Hansen was homeless. However, Hansen freaked out one day and Victim 1 advised Hansen that he was not allowed to stay with him.

Today, Victim 1 said he was home and heard knocking at the front door. Victim 1 opened the door not knowing who it was. Victim 1 saw that it was Hansen. Victim 1 stated he had not seen Hansen for at least a month. When Victim 1 opened the door, Hansen pushed his way in forcing the door inwards and came inside the house. Victim 1 yelled at Hansen to leave. Hansen did not leave.

Victim 1 stated that Hansen had a crazed look on his face. Victim 1 stated that Hansen was holding a gas can in one hand and a torch lighter in the other hand. Hansen was actively flicking the torch lighter to demonstrate a flame. Hansen told Victim 1 to “see what happens” and to “dare me to.” As he was saying this, Hansen was holding the gas can up and actively flicking the lighter. Victim 1 perceived this to be a direct threat to start himself or his house on fire.

Victim 1 stated he grabbed a baseball bat and held it up telling Hansen the leave. Hansen eventually left and left behind the gas can.

Sergeant Wood recovered the gas can which had a small amount of liquid which was believed to be gasoline in it.

Sergeant Wood spoke with a gas station clerk who stated Hansen was present and cashed in a one-dollar lottery ticket. Hansen tried to use the one dollar worth of winnings to put gasoline in a gas can that he brought. The clerk stated that the gasoline pumps were not working.

Officers also spoke with a witness who knew Hansen. The witness stated that Hansen stopped over at his residence and made comments that the police were looking for him. Hansen also told the witness that he pushed a door in. Hansen asked the witness if he could stay at the witness's residence. The witness declined and Hansen left.

Law enforcement conducted an extensive search including using canines and drones to search for Hansen. He was not located.

Hansen's whereabouts are unknown. He also is an active danger to public safety. A warrant is requested.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
