The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1

Maximum Sentence: 7 years or \$14,000 fine or both.

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Charge Description: On or about April 19, 2025 at 5:30 PM, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Lori Jean Antonson did, intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On April 19, 2025 at 5:48 p.m. Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a thrift store in Mankato to investigate a shoplifting incident. A female stole an entire cart full of merchandise. That female was ultimately identified as Lori Jean Antonson (DOB 01/12/1961)

Victim 1 had reported that the suspect was driving a red Mitsubishi Endeavor with license plates numbered DLA508. Victim 1 then called and reported that the Mitsubishi was repeatedly ramming Victim 1's vehicle Antonson was getting out of her vehicle, yelling at Victim 1, then got back into the Mitsubishi and continued to ram Victim 1's vehicle.

Victim 1 said that they had seen Antonson walking out with a loaded shopping cart. Victim 1 told Antonson she had to pay for the items. Antonson indicated that she was not going to do that and put the merchandise into Her Mitsubishi. Antonson blocked her in and called 911.

Antonson yelled at Victim 1 to get out of her way and move Victim 1's car. Antonson then got into the Mitsubishi and began to smash into Victim 1's car. Victim 1 reported that Antonson would pull her car back then "floor it" backwards into Victim 1's car. Victim 1 was so frightened she stayed in her car until police arrived.

Upon arrival officers saw that Victim 1's vehicle was blocking Antonson's vehicle. Antonson was arrested. Officers found items with the thrift store's barcodes and tags.

Officer Wagner administered the Miranda warning to Antonson at the scene. Antonson claimed she purchased the items. When asked for receipts, Antonson stopped cooperating. Antonson asked Officer Wagner to retrieve her pink wallet out of her car.

The wallet was found to contain multiple price stickers from the thrift store. Also in the car were approximately 50 to 100 price tags that had been torn from merchandise from the thrift store and two other Mankato businesses.

A person from the thrift store assisted officers in matching the items to the stickers. Each item was photographed. The items stolen totaled \$352.99.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS
