The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Fleeing a Peace Officer in a Motor Vehicle

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.3

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and one day or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/25/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030943

Charge Description: On or about September 25, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Arnold Mbuu Dinse did by means of a motor vehicle, flee or attempt to flee a peace officer who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, and the perpetrator knows or should reasonably know the same to be a peace officer.

COUNT II

Charge: Traffic - Reckless driving; Drives Consciously Disregarding a Substantial or Unjustifiable Risk

Minnesota Statute: 169.13.1(a)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/25/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030943

Charge Description: On or about September 25, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Arnold Mbuu Dinse, did drive any vehicle or light rail transit vehicle while aware of and consciously disregarding a substantial and unjustifiable risk that the driving may result in harm to another or another's property and that risk was of such a nature and degree that disregard of it constituted a significant deviation from the standard of conduct that a reasonable person would observe in the situation.

COUNT III

Charge: Traffic Regulation - Keep to the Right

Minnesota Statute: 169.18.1, with reference to: 169.89.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000, or both

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/25/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030943

Charge Description: On or about September 25, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Arnold Mbuh Dinse did failed, upon a roadway of sufficient width, to drive upon the right half of the roadway and did so in a manner or under circumstances so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property.

COUNT IV

Charge: Traffic - Speeding - Exceed Limit

Minnesota Statute: 169.14.2(a)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/25/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030943

Charge Description: On or about September 25, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Arnold Mbuh Dinse, did operate a motor vehicle in excess of the posted speed limit; to wit: 59 mph in a 30 mph speed zone and the violation was committed in a manner or under circumstances so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 25, 2026, at 10:48PM, Officer Hickey with the Mankato Department of Public Safety was on patrol in the City of Mankato. At that time, Officer Hickey observed a vehicle traveling 59MPH in a 30MPH zone on Stadium Rd. Officer Hickey, who as a stop light at the intersection of Stadium Rd. and Ellis Ave., turned to conduct a traffic stop. As Officer Hickey sped up to initiate a traffic stop, he initiated his emergency lights and siren. He observed the vehicle pass another by going over a solid yellow line that caused the second vehicle to have to swerve to the right. Officer Hickey noted that in response to his emergency lights being activated, other vehicles were pulling over the side of the road. The suspect vehicle continued to travel eastbound on Stadium Rd. at a fast rate of speed and then again passed another vehicle on the left side and then passed another vehicle on the right side on the shoulder. The vehicle then turned into a gas station where Officer Hickey made contact with the four occupants.

The driver was identified as Arnold Mbuh Dinse (DOB 09/28/06). Dinse told Officer Hickey he needed to get gas. Sergeant Wood noted the area of travel Mbuh Dinse was on his a high traffic and high pedestrian area.

Mbuh Dinse has been convicted of 8 moving traffic offenses in the past 11 months.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
