The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Harassment; Restraining Order-Violate w/in 10 yrs of prev domestic violence conviction/adjudication

Minnesota Statute: 609.748.6(c)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/03/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26013696

Charge Description: On or about May 3, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Wyatt Earl Carlson did violate a restraining order issued under M.S. 609.748 within ten years of a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or adjudication of delinquency.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 4, 2026, Officer Wanderscheid of the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to a report of a violation of a Harassment Restraining Order within Blue Earth County. Officer Wanderscheid responded and spoke with Victim 1 who reported that Wyatt Earl Carlson (DOB: 09/08/1984) had violated a Harassment Restraining Order.

Victim 1 is listed as the protected party in a Harassment Restraining Order involving Carlson. The Harassment Restraining Order was granted by a Blue Earth County District Court Judge on March 30, 2026, and served upon Carlson on March 31, 2026. The Order remains in effect until March 30, 2028.

Under the Harassment Restraining Order, Carlson is precluded from having any direct or indirect contact with Victim 1, including any contact via electronic means such as email or social networking sites.

Victim 1 reported that, on May 3, 2026, Victim 1 began receiving messages from Carlson on a Facebook account. Officer Wanderscheid noted that there were approximately 13 Facebook messages from Carlson to Victim 1, starting on May 3rd, 2026, and continuing into May 4th, 2026, at approximately 1200 hours. Officer Wanderscheid also reported several since-deleted Facebook messages from Carlson to Victim 1 during this time.

Carlson has one Qualified Domestic Violence Related Conviction for Violation of a Harassment Restraining Order in 07-CR-24-3471 (convicted on April 28, 2025).

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
