The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/22/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030557

Charge Description: On or about September 22, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Amanda Josephine Landgren, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe, after having been previously convicted of a violation of Chapter 152.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the afternoon on September 22, 2026, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence in Blue Earth County after Witness 1 reported an unknown person was sleeping on Witness 1's girlfriend's balcony.

The unknown person was eventually identified as Amanda Josephine Landgren (DOB: 09/03/1990). Officer Keane spoke with Landgren who reported she was chased into Witness 1's girlfriend's apartment and locked on the balcony by an unidentified person. Keane reported Landgren showed signs of paranoia. Keane felt it was unsafe for Landgren to be left on her own and transported her to the hospital for an evaluation.

A little over an hour later, Witness 1 went to the Public Safety Center in the City of Mankato and met with Sergeant Wood. Witness 1 reported that he had discovered a bag on the balcony where Landgren had been sleeping. Wood searched the bag for identifying information and discovered several crystalline fractures, consistent with methamphetamine, lining the inside of the bag. Also inside the bag was a purse with Landgren's driver's license and another card with Landgren's name on it. Additionally, there was a black lock case with an empty syringe, a clear plastic baggie with a large crystalline rock that weighed 2.16 grams and field tested positive for methamphetamine, a straw with white residue that field tested positive for methamphetamine, and a loaded syringe with a liquid that tested positive for methamphetamine.

Landgren was convicted on March 30, 2022, of violating Minnesota Chapter 152, in Court File No. 70-CR-21-6907.

Landgren is currently at a detoxification center, and the State requests a warrant.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
