COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Predatory Offender - Knowingly commits act or fails to fulfill registration requirement

Minnesota Statute: 243.166.5(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/22/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26022043

Charge Description: On or about June 22, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Bradley Allen Schlueter did, as a person required to register under section 243.166, who was given notice, knows, or reasonably should know of the duty to register, knowingly commit an act or fail to fulfill a requirement that violates any provision of this section.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Bradley Allen Schlueter (DOB: 06/17/1968) is required to register as a Predatory Offender in the State of Minnesota.

In the evening on July 14, 2026, Schlueter was the subject of a suspicious person complaint in the City of Mankato. Officer Hermanson had been advised that Schlueter was noncompliant with his Predatory Offender Registration requirements, specifically for failure to complete weekly check-ins with law enforcement while he is homeless.

When Schlueter was released from the Blue Earth County Jail on June 15, 2026, he listed his primary address as homeless. The same form advised Schlueter he needs to complete weekly check-ins with law enforcement while he is homeless. There is no record of Schlueter completing a check-in since June 15, 2026.

Officer Hermanson made contact with Schlueter in the City of Mankato. Schlueter stated he was still homeless in the City of Mankato.

Schlueter has the following convictions for failing to comply with his Predatory Offender Registration requirements: (1) Court File No. 07-CR-22-4482 – convicted April 24, 2024; (2) Court File No. 07-CR-14-2796 – convicted July 6, 2015; and (3) Court File No. 07-CR-14-1221 – convicted July 7, 2014.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
