COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault-GM-Subsequent Violation

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.2, with reference to: 609.2242.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26022494

Charge Description: On or about July 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daniel Patrick Parrott, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another and has a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or an adjudication of delinquency within ten years.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 18, 2026, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to Parking lot located in the City of Mankato, within the County of Blue earth due to a report of an individual who had been hit by a silver car and the vehicle had left the scene. Officer Aaron Gelle spotted a silver Chevrolet Impala bearing MN license plates KVVU497 that had a very distinct body imprint on the driver side windshield.

Officers Marzolf and Gelle made contact with the registered owner of the vehicle Mia Byers (DOB 08/24/1991), who eventually admitted that that an altercation with herself and Daniel "Patrick" Parrot earlier. Byers confirmed that Daniel "Patrick" Parrot (5/10/1991) is her boyfriend, and that Parrot was the male who had been allegedly hit by her car.

The 911 Caller, Witness 1 reported the following information:

- Witness reported that a female struck a male with her car
- The male appeared to be injured
- The female left the scene driving a silver 4-door car
- Witness had lost sight of injured male

Witness 1 provided law enforcement with cell phone recordings of the incident. The videos show Parrot laying on the ground moaning in pain while a female voice is yelling. Byers is observed walking towards Parrot. Parrot then winds up and strikes Byers in the face. Law enforcement arrested Byers and transported her to the Blue Earth County Jail. Byers has two previous qualified domestic violence related offenses within the past 10 years.

Law enforcement discovered that Parrot was out on release conditions related to previous domestic. It was also reported that Parrot may have sustained injuries from being hit by the car.

Officers then located and made contact with Parrot. Parrot was placed arrested for Domestic assault against Byers. Parrot was transported to the Emergency Room as a precaution due to being hit by a car driven by Byers. He was ultimately discharged and booked into the Blue Earth County Jail. Parrot has one previous domestic violence related offense within the past 10 years.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
