COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Disorderly Conduct - Offensive/Abusive/Boisterous/Noisy/Obscene

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/11/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26001028

Charge Description: On or about July 11, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Dylan Alen Larson did, in a public or private place, including on a school bus, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 11, 2026, Sgt. Ganglehoff of Lake Crystal Police Department responded to an address within the city of Lake Crystal, Minnesota, within the County of Blue Earth. The complainant Witness 1 reported that Dylan Alen Larson, (DOB 09/13/2001) had been drinking a lot throughout the day. Witness advised Larson had vomited and may have some gotten puke into his lungs. When Sgt. Ganglehoff arrived, it appeared that Larson was having trouble breathing, however was conscious and alert.

Sgt. Ganglehoff observed a silver Chevrolet truck bearing MN Plate 3DR-590 parked in the driveway. Sgt. Ganglehoff observed Witness 1 who advised that she had possession of the keys to the truck. Larson was seated in the driver's side seat of the vehicle while Witness 2 was trying to calm him down. Larson appeared to be sweating profusely; his face was extremely flush and was yelling/screaming out. Larson's offensive language and behavior was causing nearby neighbors to watch what was occurring nearby. Larson was eventually taken out of the truck by utilizing a modified takedown.

Eventually, Sgt. Ganglehoff rode with the Ambulance that had arrived on scene to transport Larson to the local hospital.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
