The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault-Felony

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.4, with reference to: 609.2242.4

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/03/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26006457

Charge Description: On or about March 3, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Amanda Jean Schulz did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another and has two or more previous qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency within ten years following discharge from sentence or disposition for that offense.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 3, 2026, Law enforcement was dispatched to Business 1, located within Blue Earth County, City of Mankato, Minnesota. Witness 1 reported that a naked female Amanda Jeenz Schulz (DOB: 2/22/1990) was wondering around Business 1. Upon arrival Officers Carver Christianson and Austin Cook spoke to Witness 1. Witness 1 informed the Officers that he wanted her removed from Business 1.

The Officers then contacted Schulz at her unit within Business 1. Schulz was only wearing pants and had her breasts exposed. When speaking with Schulz, Officers could detect a strong odor of a consumable alcoholic beverage. Schulz showed was noticeably intoxicated and displayed several indicia of intoxication. While speaking with Schulz her mood would change from laughing hysterically to upset. Schulz was unable to care for herself due to her intoxication. Schulz was then detained for her safety and to prevent further escalation.

MCAS arrived on scene and evaluated Schulz on scene in their ambulance. During this time, she had become uncooperative, and stated she wanted to die. Schulz was placed in four point restraints. She was then transported to MCHS.

While at MCHS, BEC Dispatch informed Officers that Probation agent K. Baden advised that Schulz had assaulted one of her clients Victim. Officer Christianson contacted Victim in the BEC Justice Center Lobby Officer Christianson learned that Victim and Schulz have been for a significant romantic/sexual relationship for a couple of weeks. Victim and Schulz have gotten into multiple arguments the past couple days. Schulz had attempted to speak with Victim multiple times but Victim did not answer. On 3/3/2026 Schulz and Victim spoke via phone which led to Victim going to Business 1 to see Schulz. While there Victim and Schulz engaged in consensual intercourse. Shortly after Schulz became upset with Victim and grabbed his neck and pinned him against the bed for approximately one minute. Officer Christianson noticed several red scratches on Victim's neck. Victim indicated that this caused him pain, and he was afraid she was going to hit him again. Victim also stated that Schulz had punched him in the head days prior.

Schulz was eventually medically cleared from by MCHS and transported to Blue Earth County Jail. During the transport Schulz was notified that she was being charged with Domestic Assault. Schulz responded with argumentative and threatening behavior regarding Victim.

Once at the BEC jail, the jail staff refused to take custody of Schulz due to her .29 BAC level. Schulz was then transferred to Rochester Detox.

Schulz has been convicted of three prior Domestic Violence Related Offenses within the last 10 years with the oldest being from October 2021.

Due to Schulz being in Rochester Detox, a warrant is appropriate in this matter.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
