COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Damage to Property - 1st Degree - Value Reduced Over \$1000

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26015078

Charge Description: On or about May 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Isaac Quentin Murray did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$1,000.00, as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

COUNT II

Charge: Damage Property - 2nd Degree - Because of Bias; Victim

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1a(a)(2)

Maximum Sentence: 366 days or \$3,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26015078

Charge Description: On or about May 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Isaac Quentin Murray did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and did so in whole or in substantial part because of the victim's or another's actual or perceived association with another person or group of a certain or perceived race, color, ethnicity, religion, sex, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, age, national origin, or disability as defined in section 363A.03

COUNT III

Charge: Fleeing a Peace Officer By a Means Other Than a Motor Vehicle

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.6

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26015078

Charge Description: On or about May 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Isaac Quentin Murray, did, for the purpose of avoiding arrest, detention, or investigation, attempted to evade or elude a peace officer who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, by means of running, hiding or any other means other than fleeing in a motor vehicle.

COUNT IV

Charge: Disorderly Conduct - Offensive/Abusive/Boisterous/Noisy/Obscene

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26015078

Charge Description: On or about May 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Isaac Quentin Murray did, in a public or private place, including on a school bus, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 16, 2026, Officer Aaron Gelle and Sgt. Brianna Wagner of Mankato Department of Public Safety were working a routine foot patrol in downtown Mankato. Officers heard a loud crash and then observed Business 1 had a shattered front window and two heavier set males were now running away from the area. Bystanders nearby confirmed that the two heavier set males had broken the window. Business 1 is in the city of Mankato, within the County of Blue Earth.

Officer Gelle proceeded after them at a light jog yelled "Stop, Police". The individuals continued to run; however, Officer Gelle was able to catch up with them. The individuals were identified as Rylan Wilson and Isaac Murray. Officer Gelle asked about the window and Murray immediately took the blame and that Wilson had nothing to do with it. Murray admitted that he was intoxicated and that his common sense had gone out the window. Wilson stated that Wilson had initially pointed at the window that the window that displayed a Rainbow Pride Flag and said it was "fuckin gay." Upon pointing that out Murray hit the window and shattered it. Officer Gelle observed Murray to have bloodshot watery eyes, slurred speech, an unsteady gait, and strong odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath and person.

Murray was asked to take PBT, to which he declined. Murray was then placed in handcuffs and was escorted to a patrol vehicle and then transported to the Public Safety Center and placed in a holding cell. Due to other circumstances law enforcement was unable to transport Murray to New Ulm Detox. It was determined that both Murray and Wilson had a safe place for the night in which they were dropped off by Officer Slattery.

Officer Gelle was able to review footage of the incident. The footage showed Wilson and Murray walking by the window with Wilson pointing at the window. Immediately after it shows Murray deliver a kick with his left foot and the glass shatters. They both immediately flee on foot.

On June 24, 2026, Officer Gelle received receipts from the owner of Business 1. The receipts indicated that initial temporary repair was necessary to ensure no could easily access Business 1 cost \$93.60. A second receipt provided by Owner of Business 1 was the final repair bill of \$1,400. The total amount of damages to Business 1 is \$1,493.60.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
